



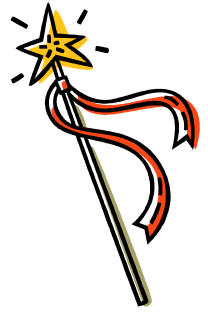

- ▶ **Saturday:** First session at 9:00 am; campfire ending at 10:00 pm. Saturday sessions will include lots of singing, dancing and drama, plus time to visit the Market Place.
- ▶ **Sunday:** Sessions from 9:00 am till noon, including a closing campfire. You can stay for lunch or make and take a bag lunch.

Facility: Camp Arbuckle is situated on the shores of Okanagan Lake in Lake Country. There are two buildings: one with activity rooms and kitchen, the other a 2-story dormitory.
